

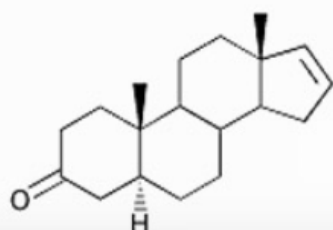
# Interesting Information about The Use Of Human Pheromones

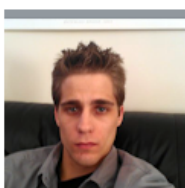
